Mailbox Coordinator

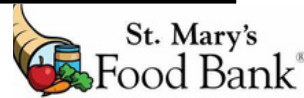

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN

Coconino County

A NOTE FROM OUR DISTRICT SUPERVISOR

For the last four years, it has been my honor to represent District 1 on the Coconino County Board of Supervisors. District 1 is a large District which encompasses most of western Flagstaff and travels along old Route 66 and Route 66 north along state highway 180 through the ranch lands and into the towns of Valle, Tusayan, South Grand Canyon Village, and to the base of Grand Canyon at Supai village. The eastern Flagstaff boundary stops at the Cedar Safeway shopping center. District 1 is as diverse as it is large. District 1 includes Flagstaff and rural communities.

My travels to Valle, Tusayan and the South Rim have provided me an opportunity to meet with business owners and residents working to fostering economic development along these Grand Canyon gateway communities and see, first hand, their commitment to preserving rural and historic roots while adopting innovative alternative lifestyles emphasizing sustainability, energy efficiency, and quality of life.

Working together with Canyon Community Alliance (CCA), and Michael Scott, Grand Canyon Food Pantry, and others, have given me insight into the resurgence of a community identity and the desire and need to expand business opportunities in this area. I was pleased to partake in the Innovative Alternative Lifestyle workshop held by Miranda Baldosky at Clear Sky Resort in Valle which included a number of community members, all interested in building community which included envisioning a community center and a post office. I was able to tour a number of sustainable and off the grid homes and meet with a number of business owners; even getting a raptor demonstration and sampling the ice cream at Raptor Ranch.

Coconino County looks forward to continuing its partnership with our rural communities and working together to realizing the vision of the residents of Valle, Tusayan and the South Rim. To assist with this, and to assist in this community development process, the County will be commencing a new Area Plan for Valle. The current Area Plan is over a decade old and it is time to gather the communities and residents together to development a 10 year blueprint for Valle's future. I look forward to working closely with the communities during this visioning process and attending community meetings, as we develop a new Area Plan. This will commence after the County completes its new Comprehensive Plan. The Valle Area Plan would be a part of this larger Countywide plan.

I continue to reach out and learn from each of you so together we can advocate for rural quality of life which maintains the identity and history of these beautiful communities
